

Step by Step Making of Play doh Ganesh Idol

Step 1: Choose colorful play dough. First make the stool on which ganesha would be seated.



Step 2: Go from bottom to top. Choose bright colored playdoh and make legs. Gives a feel that Ganesha is wearing some colorful dhoti! Use yellow/pale color playdoh for body, hands and face.

Step 3: Add some details like border for the (bright colored) dhoti.





Step 4: Make hands for lord Ganesh. Decorate with ornaments like colorful malas (chains) and the sacred thread (in white).

Step 5: Shape the doh to resemble "elephant face". Slightly adjust the ears such that they look floppy.



Step 6: Place head over the body.

Step 7: Use black playdoh to make eyes. Make one tusk smaller than other to symbolise "EK DANTH". Add some details like earrings, sacred ash and mukut (placed on head)



Step 8: Here is the umbrella that I prepared for lord ganesh. I have used mini muffin paper liner, tooth-pick and a white colored bead. You can also use cocktail umbrellas.

Step 9: Here is our cute play doh ganesh with his tiny umbrella :)
